FEBRUARY LANDSCAPING TIPS



Refresh Your Mulch

A fresh layer of mulch doesn't just enhance your landscape's appearance—it also helps regulate soil temperature and retain moisture for your plants

Apply Pre-Emergent

Combat spring weeds before they sprout! Pre-emergent fertilizer creates a barrier to stop weed seeds from germinating, particularly crabgrass and other common culprits. Apply it before soil temperatures consistently reach 55°F.

Prune Dormant Perennials and Cut Back Liriope and Ornamental Grasses

February is ideal for cutting back dormant perennial growth. Remove old stems to make room for new growth, ensuring your perennials have the space and energy to flourish in the warmer months. It's also time to trim back liriope and ornamental grasses. Cut them to about 2-3 inches above the ground before new growth starts to appear. This helps your plants stay tidy and thrive as the season progresses.
