January Landscaping Tips

Consider heavy pruning or rejuvenation pruning for overgrown shrubs.

Ornamental shrubs can often become larger than initially anticipated, and regular pruning or shearing isn't always enough to keep them under control. This is a good time of year to evaluate which shrubs might benefit from a substantial downsizing of 50% or more. Prime candidates for this practice include shrubs that are obstructing window views or encroaching on other landscape ornamentals. After this heavy pruning, these shrubs typically have little to no foliage remaining, but they will recover and re-flush in the spring.

This is the perfect time of year to address aesthetic preferences and potential safety issues.



Cut back roses and buddleias.

Both plants can benefit greatly from hard pruning in the winter. This prevents the plants from becoming top heavy, minimizes cross-branching, and encourages air flow which reduces the risk of disease.

Limb up low-branching or encroaching trees.

Large ornamental trees can cause some of the following issues as their canopies mature:

- Obstruction of foot traffic, vehicle traffic, or mower access.
- Reduced visibility.
- Growing into building structures, roofs, and gutters.
- An overcrowded appearance.
